MERCANDED BY ON THERSTON

Everyone in a general way knows of the astonishing muscular power employed by insects, and of the real tours de force which they execute either in the pursuit of prey or in defending themselves against their enemies. At the same time one rarely has a precise idea of the strength of these insects because there are few standards of comparison, although nothing is simpler than to make a correct valuation of their strength.

The wing strength of insects is known because of the work of Felix Plateau and De Lucy, who showed that these little creatures could not raise a weight much! heavier than themselves, no matter what the surface of their wings. During the course of these experiments a very interesting fact was discovered, namely, that the size of the wing dewaves as the weight and size of the animal increases, a fact which expiains the slow, heavy flight of the bestle and the swift, light
