A bushel of corn in hot weather, and with the pigs on grass, will make more pork than two bushels next winter.

Now that the harvesting is nearly all done by machinery it is pretty hard on the horses; see to it that they have the best of care and generous feeding.

Go to see the sheep at least once a week, and don't fail to make them glad to see you by taking them some salt; but your visit will be just as welcome any other day as Sunday.

Unless corn is good it is about the poorest crop a farmer can grow, and the character of the crop is more within the farmer's control than any other. Manure is never applied too heavily for corn.
