New York, N. Y., Nov.—(By The Associated Negro Press) Official investigation which followed the receipt of a letter by the Children's Society written by Long Island Baptist Orphanage, one of the girl inmates of the resulted disastrously for Wilson Johnson, 40 the superintendent of the institution.
