CLAFLIN DOWNS ALLEN
Orangeburg, Nov. 16—Exhibiting a strong defense and a fairly consistent offense, the Claflinites had little trouble in stopping Allen. The final score was Claflin 7, Allen 0. But it was a more decisive victory than the score indicates. An attempted drop kick was the closest Allen came to scoring. Twice, decisions of the officials cut down Claflin's chances for further scoring: once the ball, having been scooped up after an Allen fumble, had actually been carried across the goal line; another time the ball had been carried within five yards of goal. On another occasion the Allen line by holding for downs took possession of the ball on their six yard line. Claflin registered 13 first downs, while Allen was unable to earn a single first down. Claflin made 239 yards from scrimmage against 38 yards for Allen. Claflin completed 3 forward passes out of 9 attempts; Allen completed 1 out of 6 attempts. For 6 punts Claflin averaged 30 yards each for 10 punts. Allen averaged 26 yards each.
