He is unimpeached because unimpeachable-for it would be absurd to impute clenency to a party in which " cracking necks" is rearded as merely a "good joke." It may have been stended to reflect upon the fact that his collegiate education" was derived from an institution out of ie State. If so, we would only remark that all nose who have heard or read his letters and peeches, or who know the man, must regret that ome others do not reflect a like degree of credit on their alma mater.
