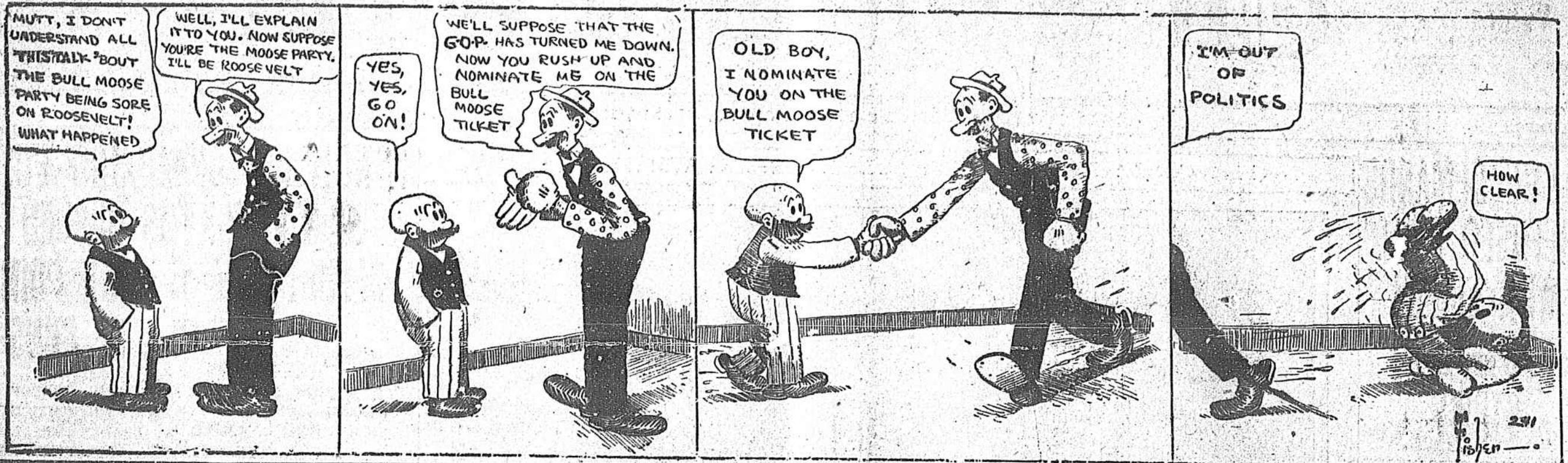

SYRUP TO REMAIN SWEET

Syrup that will neither ferment nor crystallize is the product of two years of experimentation by the department of agriculture.
The importance of this discovery to the cane growers of South Georgia and of the other southern states where the production of cane syrup is an important industry, can hardly be overestimated, says the Atlanta Constitution. It removed the great danger of the cane syrup becoming sour and the loss of the product.
The cane syrup is made by the new process, which is a double and triple refining process, formerly reserved by the producers.

GEORGIAN'S VOICE A
WINNER AT CONVENTIONLeather-Lunged Clerk Proves A
Star Performer

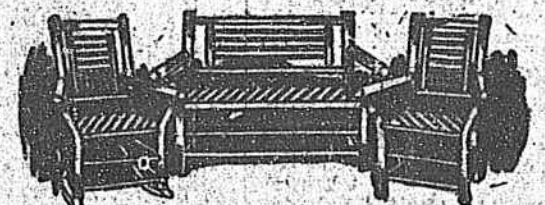
Atlanta, Ga., June 15.—Georgia had the biggest voice in the National Democratic convention, which met at St. Louis yesterday. It did not come from any one delegate or the combined delegation from Georgia; in fact, it was stronger than several delegations. "The Man With the Voice" was Devereaux F. McClatchey, of Atlanta, who served as reading clerk.

This long-legged, leather-lunged, brass-throated Georgian, as he is known, has been a star performer in the Georgia legislature for several years. He is now clerk of the Georgia State senate. He is roared for by all who have heard him in action as the possessor of the strongest voice east of the Rocky Mountains.

There is said to be a fellow who lives the life of a recluse somewhere in Yellowstone park who amuses himself every morning and evening by going out in the valley in front of his cabin and shouting aloud that he shakes off the tops of a few crags and thereby launches a landslide.

But the Rock Mountain wonder has never strayed away from his native haunts, and consequently is not a competitor of the Georgia leg man who was selected to read the Democratic delegates' instructions as to what transpired on the St. Louis convention. Devereaux McClatchey can read all day and finish stronger than he was at the start, and then if he's given a real juicy steak and a big rest spell he can read for the balance of the evening, and still get stronger and stronger.

His voice is like a fog horn whistle. It starts deep and booming, and the further it gets the louder and clearer it becomes, and no person, no matter how big, can stand the sound of it for more than a few minutes.
