A statement drawn up at the pension office shows that the number of pensioners on the roll for June 30, the end of the last fiscal year, was 983,528. This prodigious total breaks all records...

At the close of the year of hostilities, the number of pensioners of June 30, 1878, was 23,337. A year later it got into six figures, with 129,723. The increase thenceforward was steady, yet moderate...

On the contrary, the gain is the striking one of 13,850, or the biggest in four years, and with only 16,472 more to be made up, the million mark may soon be reached.
