Lists of all students selected in the lottery to receive a ticket will be posted by 5:00 PM on Monday November 6, 1989 in the Student Government Office in various Residence Hall Lobbies. There will be a primary list and three lists of alternates.

Tickets will be distributed as follows:

- 1. Students from the primary list that want to block seat will be given a block seating coupon on the ticket pick-up schedule listed in paragraph 2, which should be turned in to their organization block seating coordinator. The representative will turn the block seating coupons in at the student government office between 7:00 pm and 9:00 pm on Wednesday November 8, 1989. Students will then receive their ticket the next day.

3. Any tickets remaining after Thursday, November 9, 1989, will be available to the first alternate list on Friday, November 10, 9:00 am - 12:00 noon, second alternate list 12:00 noon -2:00 pm, third alternate list 2:00 pm - 3:00 pm any tickets remaining after 3:00 pm will be available to any student who paid their activity fee but did not enter the lottery from 3:00 pm til 5:00 pm.

Students must present a validated I.D. when picking up a ticket and when entering the stadium on game day.

There will not be guest ticket validations for the Clemson game. Student tickets may only be used by full fee paying students.

There will be no advantage to registering early for the lottery.

The best tickets will not necessarily be distributed first. Therefore, there will be no advantage to picking up your ticket early on November 8, 1989.

All band members and scholarship athletes are ineligible.
