ses were to teams ranked in the top ses were to teams ranked in the top
25 - and each of those teams sur25 - and each of those teams sur-
vived the first round of the NCAA tournament, with four making it to the Sweet 16 and three the final eight. USC beat six teams that made
the NCAA field.
"At the beginning of the season, we looked at this team and thought they could play competitively with
the best teams in the country " Whe best teams in the country,"
Wilson said. "I believe we did
that. that. "I also believe in getting
ourselves to the final 16, and havourselves to the final 16, and hav-
ing to beat the Big (Northwestern) on their home court, proves we're legitimately
one of the top 16 teams in the country," The Lady Gamecocks, whose season ended with a loss to Washington last week, were led all
season by junior Beth season by junior Beth Hunt. The
6 -foot-2-inch forward was named the Metro Conference player of the year, averaging 22.7 points and 10.2 rebounds a game.

Karen Middleton, a 5-10 junior, averaged 13.2 points and ranked 11th in the nation in 3 -point shoot-
ing percentage at 46.9 percent.

The Lady Gamecocks lose two seniors, co-captains Schonna Banner, who averaged 12.6 points and averaged 12 points and 4.2 assists.
