a cutback in RAs would not be necessary. The big problem created by not replacing outgoing RAs will be the lack of manpower and the abundance of work placed on remaining RAs, according to Jones. "The remaining RAs will have to take on extra responsibilities for the next semester," Jones said. "They're going to have to buckle down and work a lot harder to pick up the slack by doing more paper-

work or helping out tenants." McMahon, on the other hand, believes the increase in work will be minimal and handled well. He said that RHDs will have to be more involved in their hall activities and help more RAs. "Students will be encouraged to go to their RHDs or other RAs," McMahon said. "This creates more work for these RAs and RHDs, but it won't be a significant amount of work."

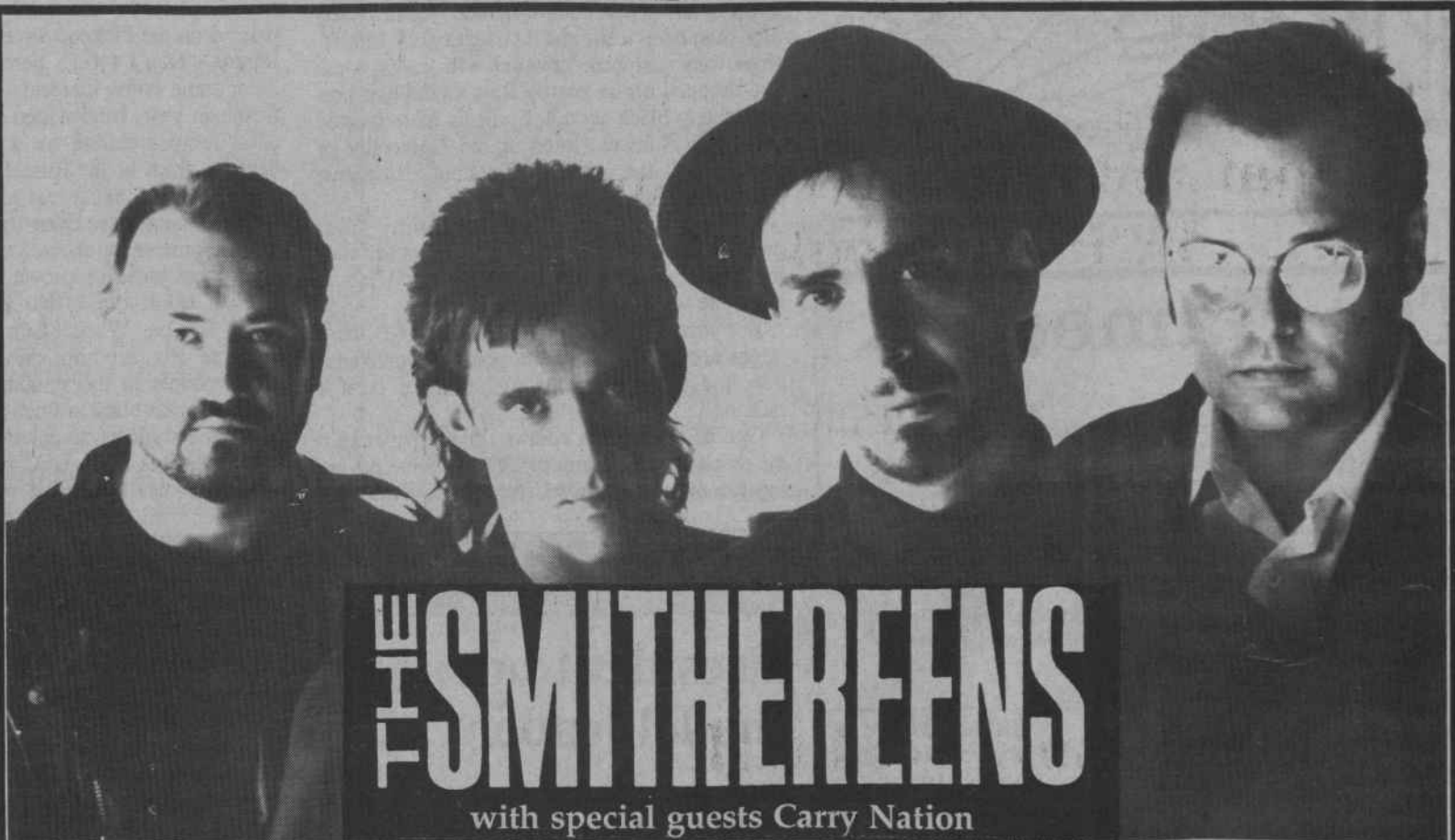
