Fans showing up at Saturday's game will notice a difference in not only the stadium but the fairgrounds as well.

As a part of the State Fairgrounds beautification project, the chain-link fence surrounding the grounds was removed, and trees were planted around the perimeter, according to Brenda Brooks, special events coordinator for the State Fairgrounds.

We put up 65 trees, everything from crepe myrtles to live oaks and put up a wrought-iron fence," Brooks
