### Men's Volleyball Club Looking for Serious Players

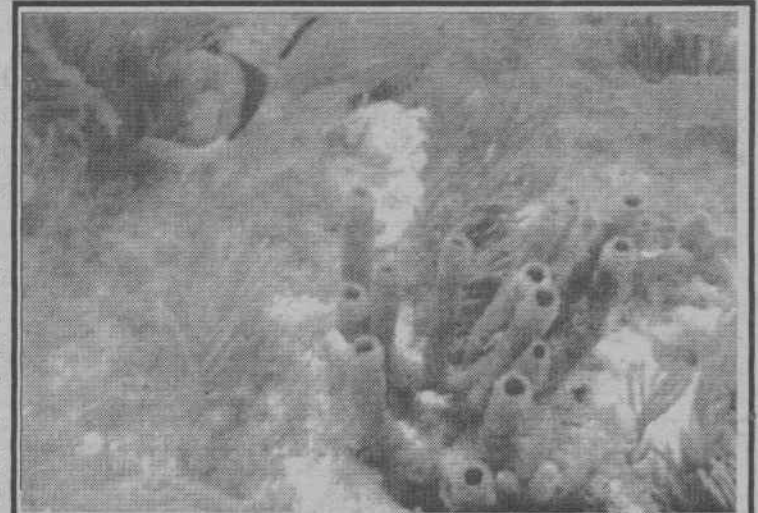
