



on getting the syllabus on. But this is on a roll," she said.

In addition to these major goals, Dickerson also has been working on projects to benefit the student body. She has worked for improved advisement through the Senate Academics committee and there is a survey to be distributed with the advisement fold-

To increase communication between the Faculty Senate and Student Senate, she has appointed a student liaison who attends meetings and reports the minutes. She has also made student safety a priority of her office with the Student Government Safety Walk and placing more call boxes around campus.

"Safety Walk was a really good thing, we had about 100 students participate. I thought this really brought attention to safety," she said.

The safety committee now has money from the Finance Committee for 15 more call boxes to be placed around

"We've worked a lot with the Master Plan and the administration this year," she said. Dickerson believes that throughout her term she has found that promises take a long time to ac-

able to receive a refund proportional to the percentage of the few dollars from their activity fees that go to organizations. Changes also were made in the same bill to some of the graduate student's funding policies.

Newman also has worked extensively with Student Government in a number of other areas.

"Earlier in the year, I worked on the Safety Walk program," Newman said. "Now I'm working with Mike Moore

on the GRADD safe ride program in hopes that it will be implemented."

This program would create a system through which students could get safe rides back from Five Points. The goal is to prevent students from driving drunk. She recently assisted in the work on the surveys for the safe ride program, which will be distributed on Election Day and determine the necessity and feasibility of the program.

Newman's other involvements through Student Government in the past year have included the Clemson/Carolina Leadership Exchange and the cosponsored blood drive.

She also has worked closely with Freshman Council on a number of special projects, and has been especially helpful with its budget and fundraising. She has been regularly available to advise organization treasurers on their jobs from managerial reports to filling out the university's forms.
