## MEN'S SOCCER

The USC men's soccer team placed four players on the All-Independent Soccer Team, as voted on by the nine teams of the Independent League.

Sophomore Joey Worthen, who was also the 1998 Independent Co-Rookie of the Year, made the first team by leading USC in points scored (25) and goals (10). The award was Worthen's second of his career.

Also making the first team were seniors Ryan O'Neill and Chris Morman. O'Neill had a terrific senior campaign with 15 points, garnering his second consecutive first-team appearance. Morman debuted on the team after chipping in solid defense for the Gamecocks.

Freshman Tim Glowienka made the second team after a strong showing in the 1999 season. Glowienka's award comes just one week after he was named Independent Player of the Week.

The annual Tigerburn pep rally will

be held Friday to support the Gamecock football team for their upcoming game against Clemson.

The event will start at 6 p.m. with a short presentation in the Russell House patio. Then, the tiger will be paraded down Assembly Street to the S.C. State Fairgrounds to be burned at 6:30 p.m.
