

The second largest seller of Guinness in South Carolina for 2000 - yep, that's Delaney's.

"I think Delaney's is a very nice bar in Five Points," Columbia resdient Jimmy Lockhart said.

Though Lockhart comes to Delaney's a couple of times a month, he doesn't frequent the bar on the infamous "Pint Night," where all beers on tap are served in pint glasses for only \$2.

Because it's not only a bar but a pub, Delaney's offers a full menu that varies from light appetizers to full-course meals.

Their late-night menu includes fried mushrooms, buffalo wings, cheese sticks, fries, chicken tenders and Philly cheese steaks.

And to wash that all down, Delaney's sells 25 different beers on tap, including Guinness, Harp, Killian's, Sierra Nevada, Sam Adams, Bass, Newcastle and Fosters.

"There's good quality people, the service is nice and there is a good beer selection," Lockhart said.


