

fashion denim designs, like Blue Cult, Seven for All Mankind, Rock & Republic and Citizens of Humanity.

Brianna Middleton of Kansas City said \$100 is reasonable for a pair of jeans with a good fit, especially because they have a long closet life.

"I have a favorite pair of jeans that fit perfectly that I have had for five years," she said. "I think a lot of people agree that jeans can get better with age, too."

If you are willing to spend \$100 or more, a good pair of jeans isn't hard to find, said Middleton, who owns at least 20 pairs. "There are so | many designer jeans on the market right now ... there is a pair for almost every figure type.'
