Tragedy in Barnwell.

Barnwell special in Sunday's State: Shooting from the dark, and hidden by the deep shadows cast by the blazing lights of the carnival now in progress in Barnwell, Perry Ussery was killed here tonight by an unknown assassin. The killing is a mystery, and no motive has been assigned as Ussery was a perfectly peaceable party. He lived near Barnwell and had come to town to enjoy the pleasures of the carnival.

The shooting occurred about 10.30 o'clock tonight, and the streets were well filled with people. Consequently the affair attracted much attention, and many drew their revolvers and fired into the shadows that concealed the skulking coward. In the melee Town Marshal Burts was shot in the leg, and Marvin Hollen was wounded in the neck. Both the men are supposed to have been wounded by the shots fired by the indignant people of the city.

Night Riders Burn Negro Church.

This is the third church that has been burned within a radius of three miles during six weeks. It is said the riders are white men.
