

BOND ORDINANCE

An Ordinance In Regard To The City Of Abbeville Issuing Coupon Bonds For The Purpose Of Improving Streets and Sidewalks In Said City, And To Fix The Time, Place and Manner of Election By The Voters Of Said City On The Question Of Issuing Coupon Bonds.

Whereas, a majority of the freeholders of the City of Abbeville, South Carolina, in the County of Abbeville, as shown by the tax books of said City of Abbeville, have petitioned the City Council of Abbeville to order an election on the question of voting coupon bonds in the sum of not exceeding ninety thousand dollars for the purpose of improving streets and sidewalks, the said bonds to bear interest at not more than the rate of five and one half per centum per annum, payable semi-annually and in such denominations and for such length of time as the said City Council shall deem advisable and designate by proper ordinance.

Now therefore, Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Abbeville and by authority of same;

That an election be held in the City of Abbeville, South Carolina, on the 27th day of April 1920, the same being Tuesday between hours of eight o'clock in the morning and four o'clock in the evening, in the Office of the City Council wherein the Mayor holds his Court, in the City Hall of said City of Abbeville, upon the question of issuing coupon bonds of the City of Abbeville in the sum of not exceeding ninety thousand dollars; said bonds to bear interest at not more than the rate of

five and one half per cent per annum payable semi-annually and be in such denominations and for such length of time as the said City Council shall deem advisable and designate by proper ordinance, said bonds to be so issued for the purpose of improving the Streets and Sidewalks of the said City of Abbeville, at which election all qualified registered electors shall be entitled to vote. At said election, those favoring the issue of said bonds shall vote a ticket on which shall be written or printed the following words:

"Shall the City of Abbeville issue coupon bonds in the sum of not exceeding ninety thousand dollars, said bonds to bear interest at not more than the rate of five and one half per centum per annum, payable semi-annually and in such denominations and for such length of time as the said City Council shall deem advisable and designate by proper ordinance, for the purpose of improving the Streets and Sidewalks in the City of Abbeville? Yes."

Those opposing the issue of said bonds shall vote a similar ticket, except the answer or word "No" shall take the place of the answer or word "Yes."

The books of Registration shall be opened by the Supervisor of Registration of said City, at his office in the said City, at the City Hall on the 7th day of April 1920, and shall be kept open for the registration of qualified electors for said City for a period of ten days as required by law.

That said election shall be conducted in all respects according to law, and every person qualified by law shall be entitled to vote there-

n. Should any Manager of same herein after appointed be disqualified, or for any reason be unable or unwilling to serve, the Mayor shall appoint a Manager, or Managers of Election to-wit: T. C. Seal, L. Clark, C. A. Botts.

Done and ratified in Council this 2nd day of April in the year of our Lord Nineteen Hundred and Twenty and in the one hundred and forty-fourth year of the Sovereignty and Independence of the United States of America.

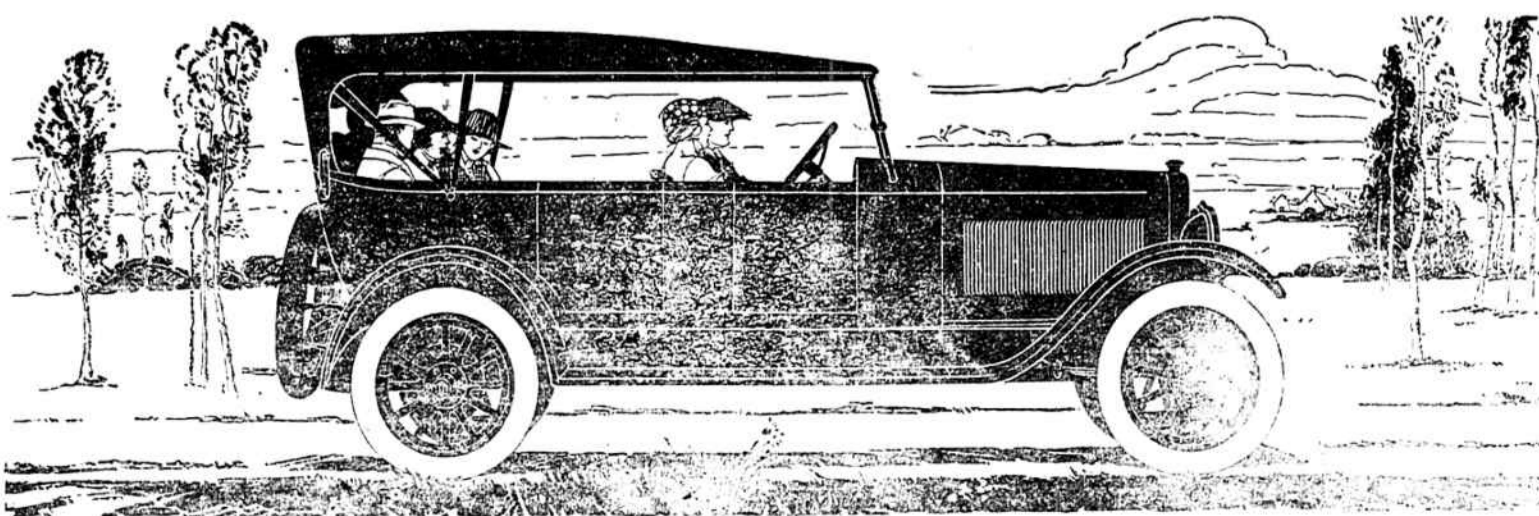
