For the purpose of meeting in part the current expenses of the city government of the City of Abbeville, S. 

Chicago, Sept. 23 .- Managers of one large hotel and three chain restaurant systems were summoned to the city hall to explain restaurant prices to the council committee on Stoves, itinerant dealer in _ 10 00 living costs.

Simultaneously, Russel Poole, sec-00 retary of the City Food Bureau, urged all downtown workers to carry their own lunches until prices come down and announced that milk will be delivered to the city hall and sold direct to employes for 10 cents
