

AMERICAN WOMEN PRETTIEST IN WORLD

Paris, July 18.—America is developing an entirely new type of feminine beauty, a type that will be as distinct and individual and even more beautiful than the classic types of Greece and Rome, according to Dr. Jack Bretton, one of Paris' foremost facial surgeons.

From the bewildering multitude of old world facial types brought together in America, no two resembling each other, American climate and American life are forming by natural selection a single composite national type, the like of which the human race has never seen before, he said.

Already it is possible to discern the first outlines of this national type, still fully fifty years will be required for it to reach perfection.

As the Greek beauty stood out as the finest example of feminine loveliness of her age, the American beauty will in turn dazzle the world with her charm.

Here are the chief characteristics of the American type:

- Cute nose, inclined to turn up. Remarkable complexion, coming from health. Brownish hair, blue eyes. Good form, resulting from athletic training.

can have a pug nose and yet fulfill the requirements of beauty quite as well as the ancient Greek girl with her long slender nose.

"Noses of American women as a rule have a tendency to turn up. Noses of American men, on the contrary, generally take the opposite direction. I don't know the cause of this difference between the sexes.

"The American beauty will have the finest complexion of any type of people the world has ever seen—due both to prohibition and her athletic habits.

"No other people, ever had the chance to grow perfect complexions that America has because no European people has ever instituted prohibition. Alcohol is the greatest enemy of beauty."
