

Something for the Boys. The boys of Georgia can do great things for themselves and the old State. If they are ambitious, industrious and full of pluck. There are many boys in the South who, by hard work, have earned an honest livelihood; but we fear there are many others who are idle, shiftless and demoralized. There are many boys who are now the support and comfort of their parents; there are many others who are nothing but clogs and encumbrances to the author of their being. It is a shame that there should be a single healthy youth in Georgia or the South who is not actively engaged in some employment which brings profit with it to his body or mind. Now and then our exchanges record some bright examples of what a boy can do who is not afraid or ashamed to labor. Only the other day, when many planters, in a distant commonwealth, were complaining that there was no profit in agriculture, it was demonstrated that quite a number of boys had, by persistent personal effort, made not only a living but a considerable sum above it. We are convinced that much of the trouble among farmers arises from the fact that they love to be "bosses" but are disinclined to go into the fields themselves and indifferent about their children doing so.

Now, we want the boys to listen to a true account of what three of their number have accomplished. A widowed lady, living not many miles from Augusta, has three sons, aged respectively, 19, 14 and 12 years. All of them attend school at the Richmond Academy, and are attentive to their scholastic duties. Every Saturday of last year, by ploughing and hoeing, with no outside aid, they cultivated a portion of the land around their mother's home. The first boy attended to two acres, the second one acre, and the third a half acre in cotton. The eldest boy made two bags of cotton, weighing 467 pounds each. The second boy made one bale, weighing 450 pounds. The youngest made 150 pounds of lint cotton. During last winter they broke two small steers, and with the assistance of their mother, attended school, they hauled from the adjacent woods an abundance of leaves and litter. This material, with 400 lbs. per acre of Dickson's compound, they applied to the poor land they had the use of. The present crop of the eldest boy is three and a half acres of cotton. The two younger boys have the same acreage as last year. The probabilities are that the eldest boy will make three and a half bales; the second boy one 500 pound bale; and the youngest lad 250 pounds of lint cotton.

Meanwhile, they have been punctual in their attendance at school, except for a period during the summer, when the younger boys were attacked with measles. At the time of their sickness they hired a hand to do their hoeing. Outside of this inevitable help all of the labor has been done by themselves. During vacation they have been busy picking out their crop, and on Saturdays they complete the gathering. These boys undertook this planting scheme of their own free will, and carried it out with judgment and dexterity, while other boys were idling. They are not obliged to work, but they are industrious, naturally, and had a teaching under the blue skies and in the open air quite as useful as that acquired in the Academy rooms. They have made the poor sandy globe to bloom. They have contributed largely, if not wholly, to pay for their education, and they have garnered up habits of thrift, energy and true manhood which will make them independent, healthy and honorable.

How many boys are there who could go and do likewise if they would only try? How much better would it be for Georgia and the South if she numbered such boys by thousands. They are deserving of praise, and we shall be glad to record any other example of youthful vigor and industry.—Constitutionalist.
