



It is best for the people not to obligate themselves to take these improvements. But will the corporators put in the plants without assurance of a certain amount of pledged patronage? Let us have water works and electric lights but also let the authorities of our town be slow in granting privilges and seek advice from towns which are more learned, because of the experience they have had.

## County Auditor's Notice.






