The great majority of the people of Edgefield county were sorely disappointed in the defeat of Hon W J Talbert, who would have made South Carolina a good, clean governor.

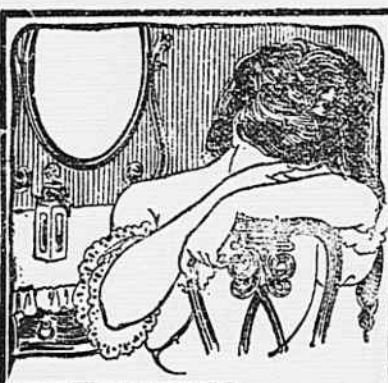
