Court Proceedings.

Court convened on Monday morning with Hon. J. C. Klugh as presiding judge. The solicitor, stenographer and other court officials were at their respective posts. On account of quarantine regulations three grand jurors and five petit jurors were prevented from attending. This, however, did not seriously retard the progress as the five mile jury box was called into requisition.

The March term of criminal docket is the lightest on record. Only three indictments, all against Edgefield fire bugs, were handed the grand jury and a true bill was found in each case. Monday was consumed with the case of the State vs Chris McManus, indicted for forgery, not guilty. The State was represented by the solicitor and J. W. DeVore, Esq., and the defendant by Messrs. S. McG. Simkins and S. M. Smith.

As we go to press on Tuesday, Ella Morse, charged with assault and battery, is being tried. The solicitor is representing the State and J. W. DeVore, Esq., the defendant.
