The County Treasurer's office will be  
open for the purpose of receiving taxes  
from the 15th day of Oct. 1908 to the  
15th of March 1909 inclusive.

A penalty of one per cent will be  
added to all unpaid taxes after the 1st  
day of Jan. to the 31st of Jan. 1909,  
of two per cent, from the 1st day of  
Feb. to the last day of Feb. 1909 and  
penalty of five per cent from the first

All male citizens between the ages  
of 21 years and 60 years except those  
exempt by law are liable to a poll tax

citizens between the ages of 18 and  
50 years.

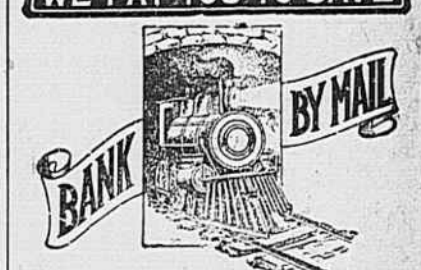
