The law as it now stands requires policemen, Sheriffs and all other peace officers to carry weapons ex posed. If this law were implicitly obeyed it would work a hardship on officers trying to do detective work The last Legislature amended the law in that particular. The new act reads:

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of South Carolina: That Section 1 of an act entitled "an act prohibiting the carrying of concealed weapons, providing a penalty therefor, and incorporating a count for the violation of the same in indictments for murder, manslaughter, assault and battery of a high and aggravated nature, assault and assault and battery with intent to kill, and in every case where the crime is charged to have been committed with a deadly weapon,' approved the 17th day of February, A. D. 1897, be, and the same is hereby amended by adding thereto, at the of said section, the following words; "or peace officers in the actual discharge of their duties as peace officer;" so that said section, amended, shail read as follows:

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of South Carolina: That any person carrying a pistol, dirk, slingshot, metal knuckles, razor, or other deadly weapon usually used for the infliction of personal injury, concealed about his person, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and, upon conviction thereof before a court of competent jurisdiction, shall forfeit to the county the weapon so carried concealed, and be fined in the sum of not more than one hundred dollars and not less than twenty dollars, or imprisoned not more than thirty nor less than ten days, in the discretion of the court. 
