engaged in making an ixivestigation of the waters inhabited by the At lantic coost salmon to gather ad ditional facts regardiug its habite, food, growth and life. They will make a study of the coastal waters of
the New England states. eight or ten years ago the commis sion made a similar experiment, but
it was a failure. About $5,000,000$ fish were released and disappeared. Different methods are to be pursued this time and it is hoped that better results may be obtainea.
