LAW AS TO CANDIDATES.

Candidates Must Now File Pledge and Swear to Itemized Statement of Campaign Expenses.

The following act passed by the legislature will be of interest to all, especially candidates. Every man who runs for office must comply with its provisions.

Section 1. At or before every political primary election, held by any municipal party, organization or association, for the purpose of choosing candidates for office of the election of delegates to conventions in this State, any person who shall by threats or any other form of intimidation, or promise of money, any other article of value, procure or offer, promise or endeavor to procure another to vote for or against any particular candidate in such election or who shall for any such consideration, offer to so vote, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.

Sec. 2 Every candidate offering for election, under the provisions of section 1, shall make the following pledge and file the same with the clerk of the court of common pleas for the county in which he is a candidate, unless he should be a candidate in more than one county, in which case he shall file same with the secretary of state before he shall enter upon his campaign to wit, I, the undersigned —, of the county of —, the State of South Carolina, candidate for the office of —, hereby pledge that I will not give nor spend money, or use intoxicating liquors for the purpose of obtaining or influencing votes, and that I shall at the conclusion of the campaign and before the primary election render to the clerk of the court (or secretary of State as hereinbefore provided), under oath, an itemized statement of all moneys spent or provided by me during the campaign for campaign purposes up to that time, and I further pledge that I will immediately after the primary election or elections that I am a candidate in, render an itemized statement, under oath, showing all further moneys spent or provided by me in said election. Provided that a failure to comply with this provision shall render such an election null and void in so far as the candidate who fails to file the statement herein required, but shall not effect the validity of the election of any candidate complying with this section. And provided further, That such itemized statement and pledge shall be open to public inspection at all times.

Sec 3 That any violation of the provisions of this act shall be a misdemeanor, and any person upon conviction thereof, shall be fined not less than \$100 nor more than \$500 or be imprisoned at hard labor for not less than one month nor more than six months, or both fine and imprisonment, in the discretion of the court.

The dairy bill of Congressman Lever passed the house. It carries an appropriation of \$20 000. This money is intended to defray the expenses of a number of dairy experts who will work in co-operation with State experiment stations and with individual dairymen.

The passage of this bill means much to the South. This State will profit immensely by it. Congressman Lever is being congratulated upon the success of the measure. He deserves to be praised. The bill has in it the possibility of the creation of a new industry in the South and the saving to Southern people of an enormous drain upon their resources. The dairying business is an immense one. The total value of the dairy products of the United States was over \$600,000,000 six years ago. It is greater today. It is one of the leading industries of the country, and has made the central and northwest ern States immensely rich.

But the South has not profited by the experience of others in this particular. This section not only does not cultivate the dairy industry, but it actually fails to supply the needs of its own markets, and comparatively few make enough butter and cheese to supply their own private tables. The South spends annually for butter and cheese alone the tremendous sum of \$38 000 000. These products could easily be raised at home. Mr. Lever is working in the right direction.—Greenville Daily News.
