Fund for Artificial Limbs.

The House Thursday passed to third reading Senator Mauldin's bill appropriating \$15,000 for artificial limbs for Confederate veterans. There was some fight on the bill on the ground that the privilege might be abused and that the appropriation should have been included in the regular appropriation of \$250,000 made for Confederate veterans. By a vote of 52 to 43 the House refused to strike out the enacting words and by a vote of 59 to 43 refused to postpone the bill. It was passed with only one change and reads as follows:

"Section 1. That every man who, while he was a bona fide soldier or sailor in the service in this State or in the Confederate States, in war between the States, lost a limb, now or hereafter to be on the pension list, shall upon application to the State pension board be entitled to be furnished with a first class artificial limb to supply such loss; provided, such application must be approved by the pension commissioners of the county in which the applicant resides.

"Sec. 2. The comptroller general is required to furnish to such applicants all necessary blanks therefor.

"Sec. 3. To carry this act into effect there is hereby appropriated the sum of \$15,000, if so much be necessary.

"Sec. 4. That all acts or parts of acts in conflict with this act are hereby repealed."

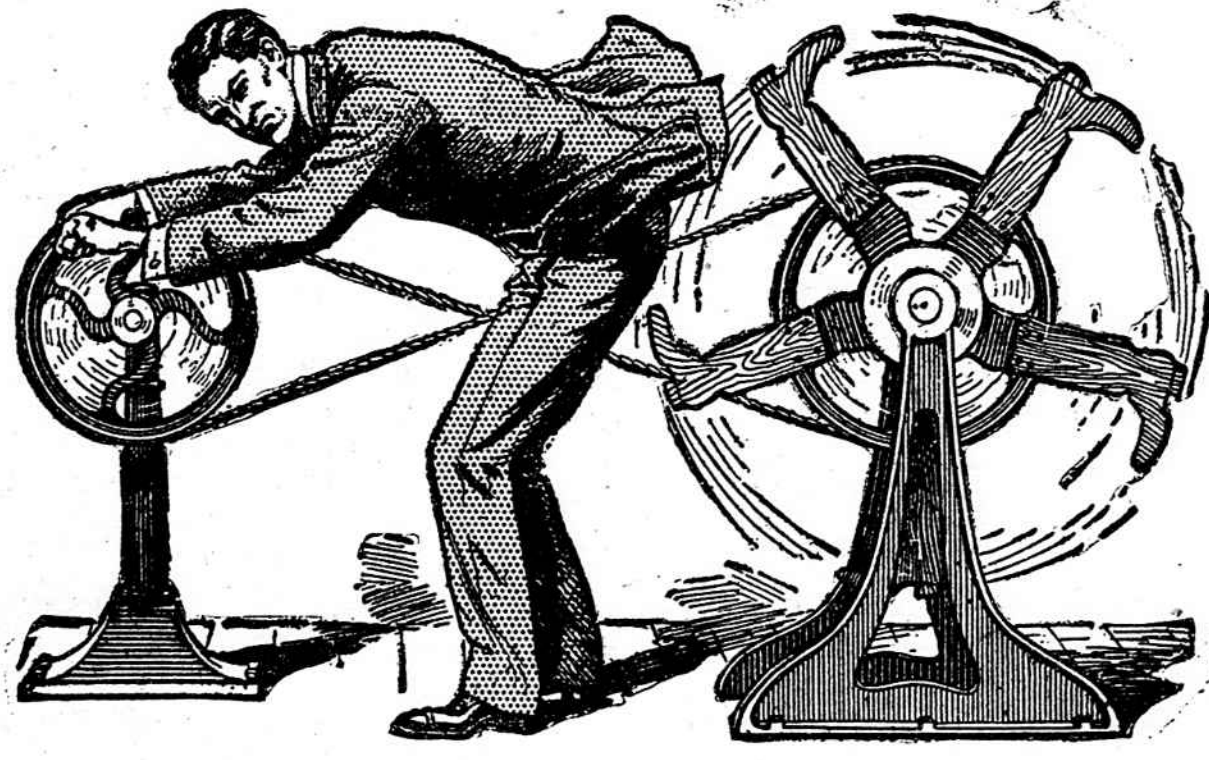
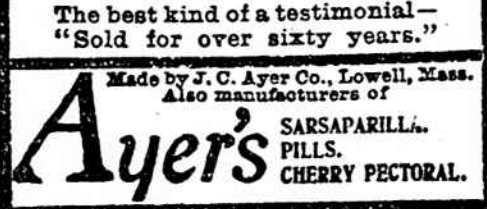

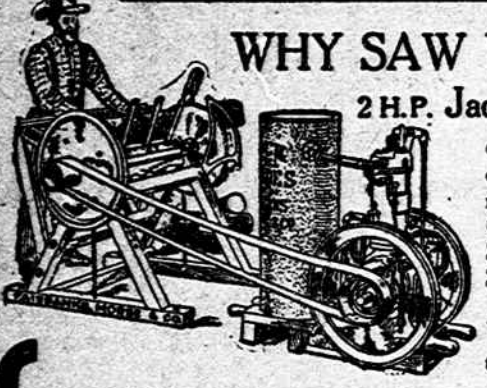
