TO FIGHT CATTLE TICK.

Congressman Lever Wins Victory in
Securing Larger Appropriation.

Congressman Lever, in the committee on agriculture, has won a considerable victory in increasing the appropriation for cattle tick eradication in the South from the \$150,000 carried in last year's bill to \$250,000 for the coming fiscal year.

It was won over the unanimous opposition of the sub-committee which makes up the bill, with the exception of Mr. Lever, who is a member of the sub-committee.

It is known, of course, that several years ago the Federal Government established a quarantine against Southern cattle, and it is estimated by statisticians that on account of this quarantine against tick-infested cattle the South suffered an annual loss of from \$80,000,000 to \$100,000,000. It is expected that the South Carolina Legislature will soon make a liberal appropriation for co-operation with the Federal Government in this work.

Mr. Lever went before the Senate committee on finance last Saturday to urge such an appropriation and he is hopeful that it will pass. It is Mr. Lever's belief that if the State will appropriate \$5,000, the Federal Government will expend in the State during the coming fiscal year at least \$15,000, and that the quarantine line in South Carolina will be carried down into the territory of Columbia. Already four of the upper counties of the State have been put in probationary quarantine and these will be released in a short time from any quarantine restrictions. At the hearing on this matter Representative Legare spoke on the importance of increasing the appropriation in the interest of the people of the South.
