#### Senator Led Mob That Lynched Negro Murderer.

Memphis, Tenn., Sept. 10.—A special from Oxford, Miss., quotes United States Senator W. V. Sullivan, as follows, with reference to the lynching last night: "I led the mob which lynched Nelse Patton, and I'm proud of it; I did everything I could to see that he was lynched. He cut a white woman's throat, and of course, I wanted him lynched. When I heard of his horrible crime, I started immediately to get a mob. I did all I could to raise one. I was at the jail last night and heard Judge Roane advise against lynching. I got up and urged the mob to lynch Patton. I aroused the mob and directed them to storm the jail. I had my revolver, but did not use it. I gave it to a deputy sheriff and told him to shoot Patton. I don't care what investigation is made, or, what are its consequences. I am willing to stand them. I will lead a mob in such case any time."

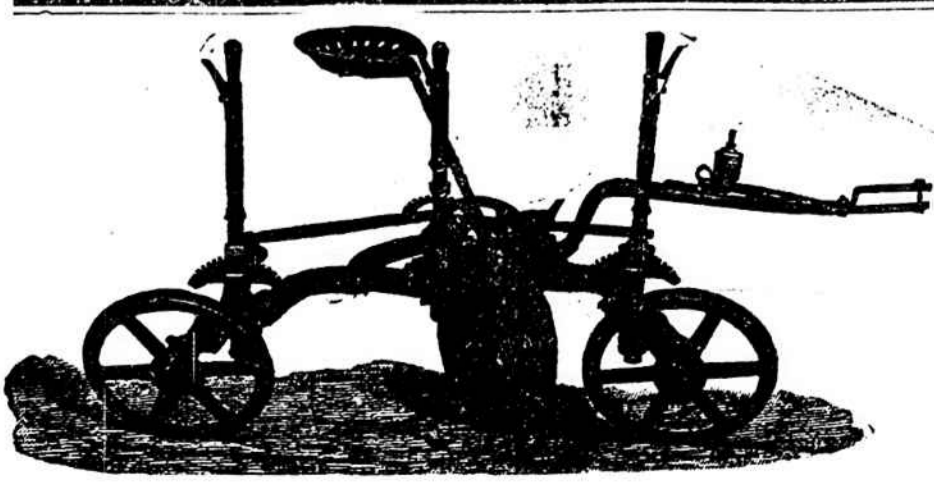
