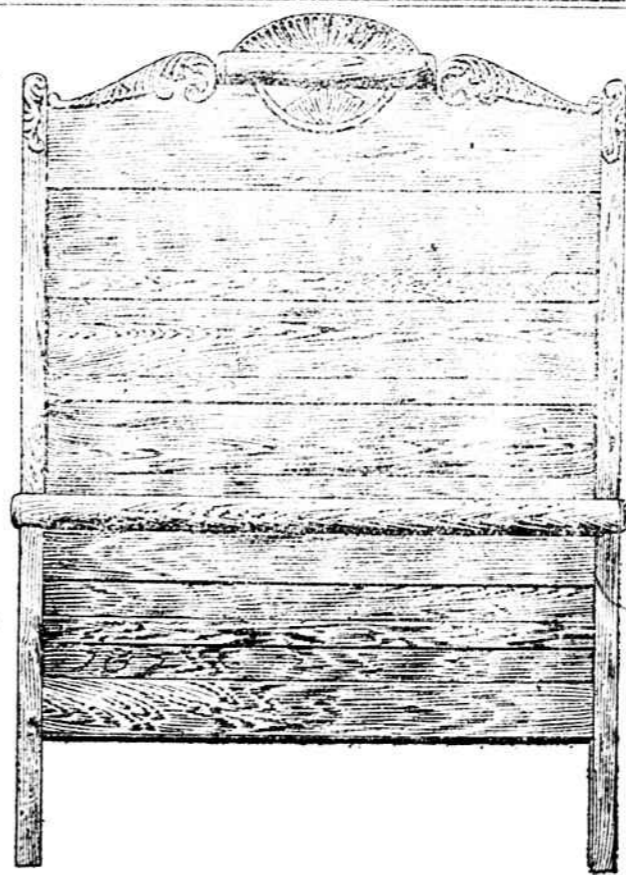

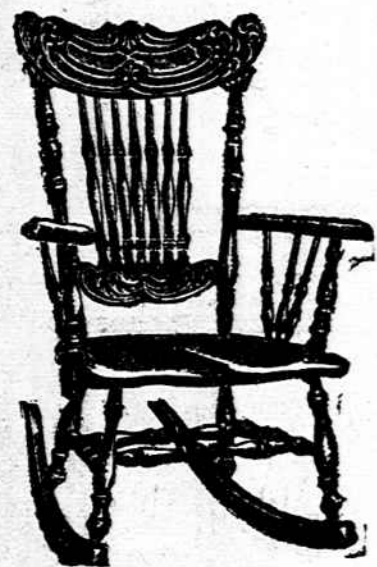
BED 75 INCHES HIGH.
