Sales Of Fertilizers.

According to figures obtained by Commissioner Watson, the total sales of fertilizer in the State during the past year was 625,048 tons, value \$15,822,583. The number of tons of cottonseed meal sold was 133,315, value \$3,496,190. The annual inspection tax collected from the sales amounted to \$189,599.75.

The above figures were derived by estimating the average price per ton of fertilizer, \$22.50, and cottonseed meal at \$26, per ton. The figures show a great increase in sales during the past several years.

In 1904 the number of tons of fertilizer sold was 494,447, value \$9,100,057.50; the number of tons of cottonseed meal, 77,169, value \$1,996,160. The total annual inspection tax derived in that year was \$120,401.75.
