At 1 p. m. a lunch will be served at the Steward's hall, to visiting teachers and guests.

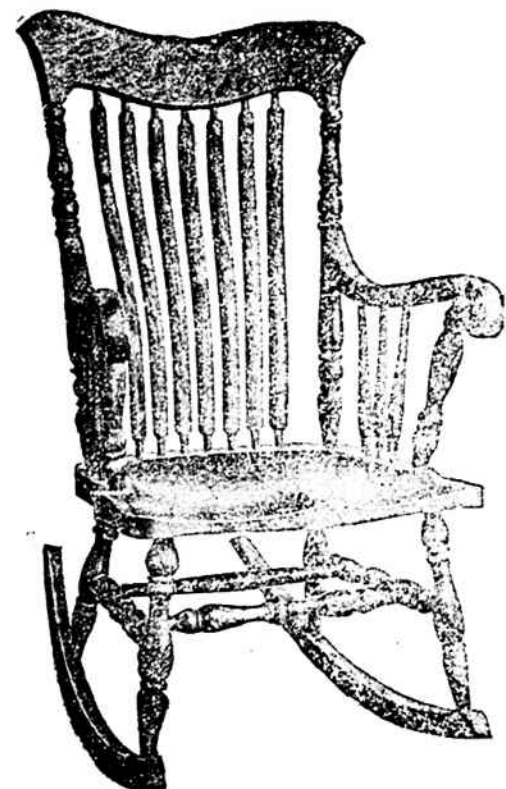
