The examination for the award of scholarships in Clemson Agricultural College will be held in the County Court House on Friday, July 8th, at 9 a. m. Applicants must fill out proper for us, to be secured from the County Superintendent of Education, before they will be allowed to stand the examinations. 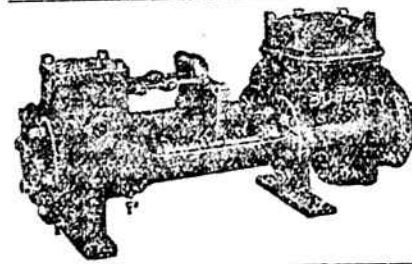
