#### Mail Clerk Could Tell What Letters Contained Money.

Postoffice inspectors say over 1,000 letters, containing small sums of money, have been taken from the mails by Franklin B. Scott, a negro, a night distributor at the postoffice in Cleveland, Ohio. Scott had six unopened letters in his pocket when arrested, the officials say.

Scott was able to pick out letters containing currency with astonishing accuracy. His finger tips were abnormally sensitive and he had trimmed his nails so that the nerves were nearly exposed. It was his slender, tapering fingers that led inspectors to suspect Scott.

He pleaded guilty before United States Commissioner Walther and was held on \$2,500 bond. Scott had been in the postal service 4 years.

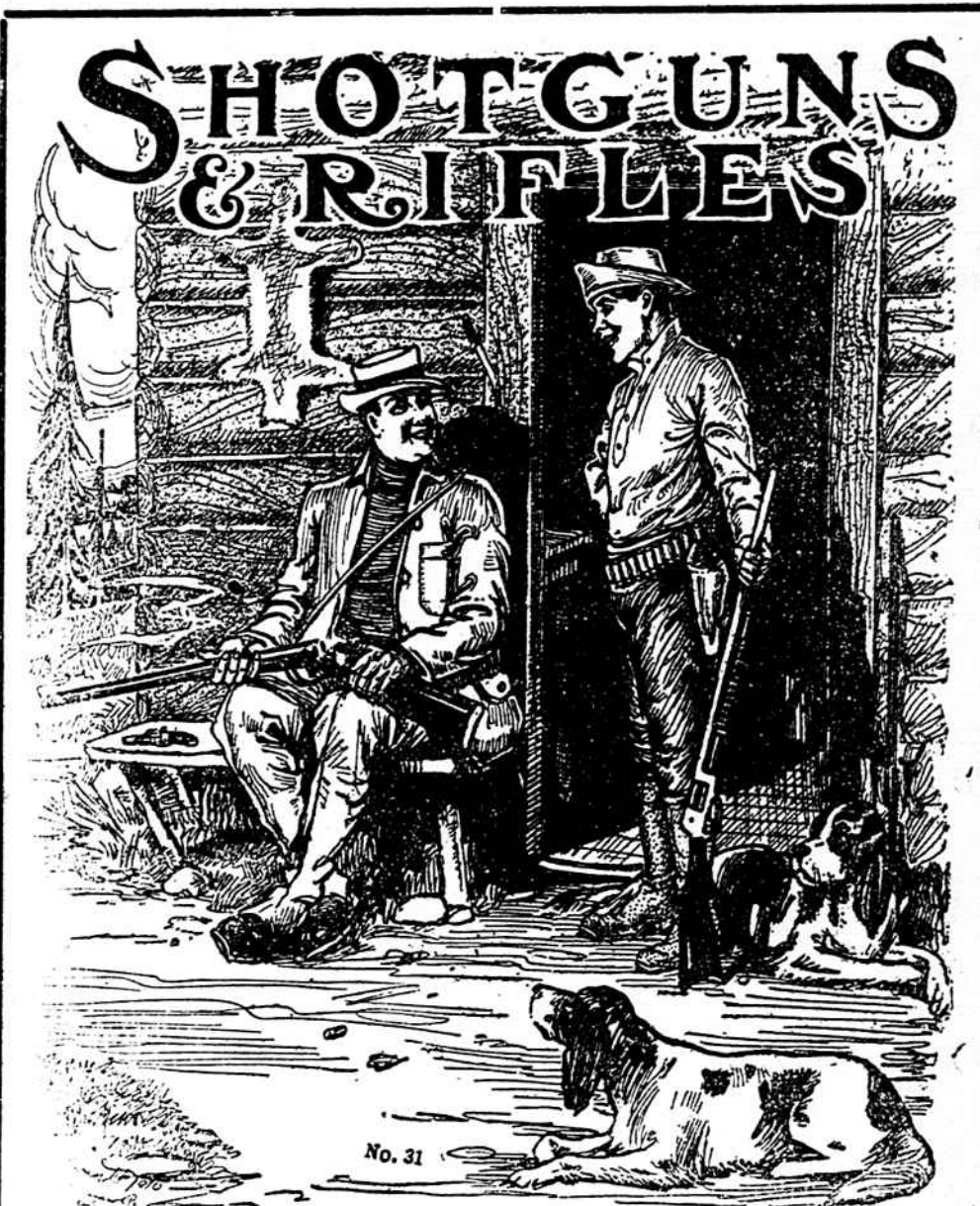
