Some Election Facts.

The primary election will be held in South Carolina on August 27.

A registration certificate and tax receipt is not necessary to vote in the primary. The registration certificate and tax receipt is required for the general election.

The requirements to participate in the primary election are:
Residence in South Carolina one year.

Residence in the county 60 days preceding the next general election.

No person shall be allowed to vote except his name be enrolled on the particular club list at which he offers to vote at least five days before the first election, which club shall have a separate polling place for primary elections; except in Charleston the voter's name must be on the particular club list at which he offers to vote at least 60 days before the primary election.

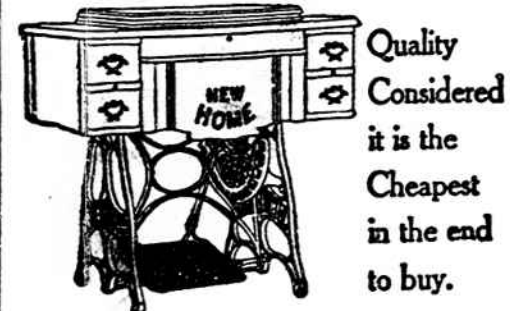

Lid Is On Tight

Columbia.—As a result of the activity of Columbia police the so-called social clubs closed business Tuesday afternoon.

While nothing definite is known it was stated that the blind tigers held a conference this afternoon when it was decided to close up the various places.

One of the clubs was fined \$280 in two days by the city officials. Mayor Gibbs is determined to put down the illicit sale of whiskey and every club will be raided every day unless the sale is stopped.

It is expected that all of the clubs will remain closed until after the election.

As was generally known Columbia was virtually a "wideopen town" until this morning. The Blease constables were very inactive and seized little whiskey. So far as the public knew a raid was seldom made. The force of Blease constables was maintained in this county at a cost of thousands of

dollars to the county.

Mayor Gibbs seeing that the Blease constables did not intend to remedy the situation took a hand himself with the result that the blind tigers have closed down business.

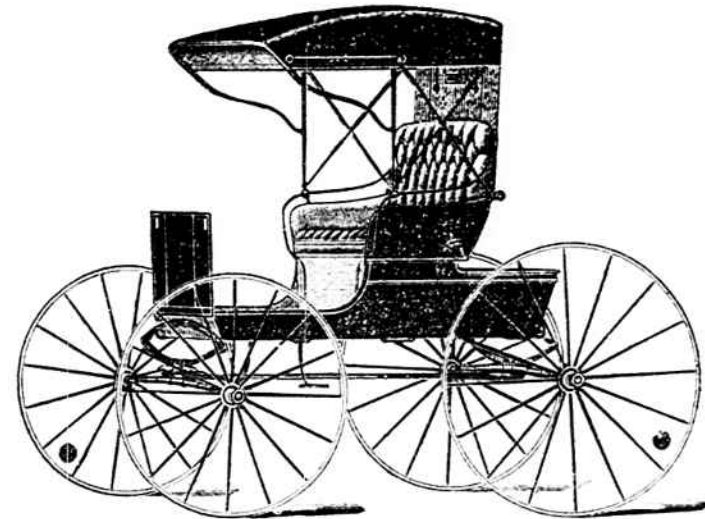
