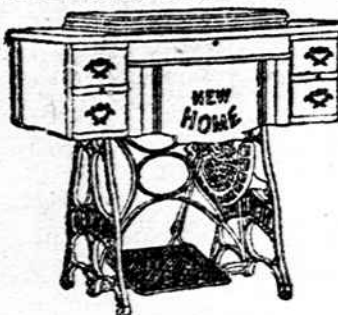

TYPHOID FEVER

Is Due to Neglect Says Dr. J. LaBruce Ward.

THE DEATH RATE IS VERY HIGH.

Another Interesting Lecture in Public Health Series Delivered at the University of South Carolina.

"For every case of typhoid fever somebody should be hung," was the remark of Dr. J. LaBruce Ward, quoting Dr. Osler, in his lecture on public health at the South Carolina University recently.

"Typhoid fever, like the poor, will always be with us," said Dr. Ward. One half million people annually have typhoid fever in the United States, and of these 40,000 die.

The oldest account of typhoid, written by a Frenchman dates from 1813, though the disease was an ancient one. Typhoid is caused by a germ discovered in 1850. This specific organism is the seed of the disease of typhoid. The three main sources of typhoid are polluted water, polluted milk and the fly which carries the germ from polluted soil to food on the table, especially milk.

Typhoid is highly communicable. The typhoid germ lives less than a day in the sunlight. Flooding houses with sunlight will prevent the growth of the germs.

Typhoid fever is especially prevalent in unsewered parts of towns. In Jacksonville, typhoid was cut down 50 per cent. by the extension of the sewerage system. Eighty per cent. of the farms of South Carolina have no prevention against soil pollution.

"The typhoid rate is the index to the intelligence of a community," said Osler. "Education means eradication of typhoid fever. Pure water, pure milk, and war against the fly will destroy the disease."—The Columbia State.
