has the champion hen of the country
in point of egg laying. Her name is
Cornell Supreme, and she is the pride
of Prof. James Rice, of the poultry
department of the college, who has
just announced her record.

The hen has laid in three years just
600 eggs, weighing an aggregate of
86.19 pounds, which is 25.82 times her
own weight in eggs. This hen, it was
announced today, has now won the
championship title over Cornell Sur-
prise, another hen, which laid 180,
186 and 196, respectively, in three
years.

Ham Baked in Milk.

Cut a thick slice of ham to weigh
two or three pounds. Soak in water
about three hours. Dry well and rub
both sides with a mixture of one ta-
blespoonful of brown sugar and one
tablespoonful of dry mustard. Put in
a pan and cover with sweet milk. Cover
and bake in slow oven for about two
hours. Milk should be absorbed by
that time.—M. B. W., in Southern
Farming.

35 States Want Direct Election.

Harrisburg, Pa., April 2 —Pennsyl-
vania today joined the ranks of the
states that have ratified the proposed
amendment to the federal constitu-
tion providing for the direct election
of United States senators, making the
thirty-fifth to fall in line. The joint

today unanimously.

needed to make the amendment ef-

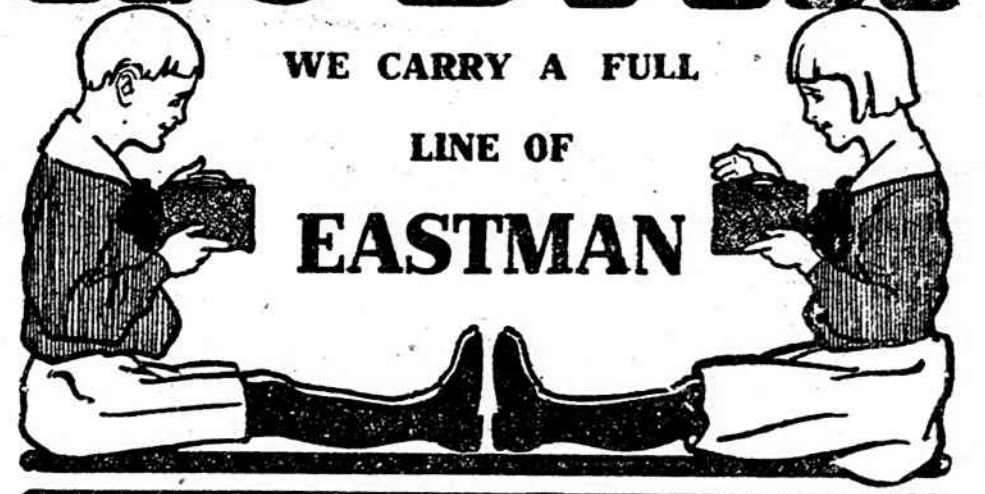
