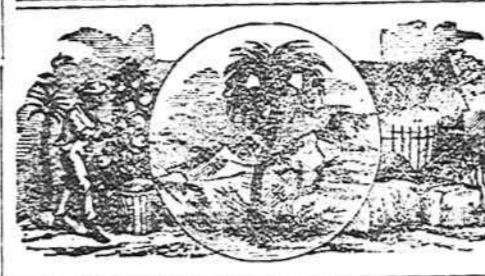

WASHINGTON, October 16.—In the Senate, during the morning hour, a large number of bills and petitions were presented and referred to appropriate committees.

In the House, after a struggle for precedence, the case of Rainey, of South Carolina, was taken up, when Mr. Cox went to the Chair to read papers from Gov. Hampton.
