Bomb-Throwing in Pekin.

Pekin, September 25 .- At the Pekin Railway station to-day, as a train carrying one of the four missions ordered abroad to study foreign political methods was leaving, a bomb was exploded inside a private car, killing four minor officials and wounding over twenty other persons. The wounded include Prince Tsai Tche, who heads the most important of the missions, and Wu Ting Fang, former minister to the United States, both of whom received slight injuries. The perpetrator of the outrage, who was in the car, was blown to pieces. The affair causes apprehension regarding the safety of members of the Court and leading officials of the Government. The Government offices and the railways are now strongly guarded.


