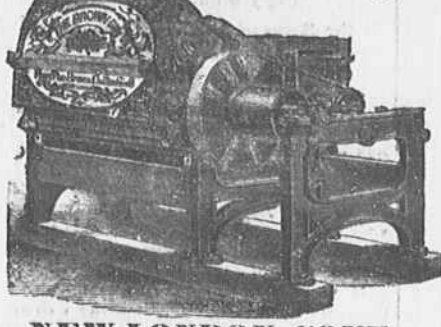

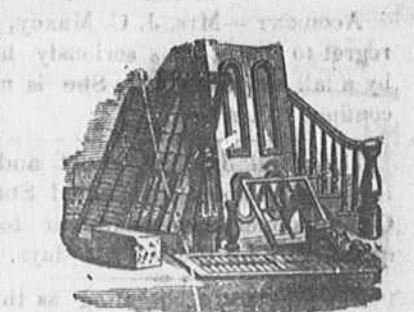

PICKENS HIGH SCHOOL, 1875.

THE Exercises of the First Term of this School will commence January 18th and end June 4th; the Second Term, July 5th and end November 19th. Students entering within two weeks after the commencement of the Terms, will be charged for the whole term; those entering after this time, from the time of entering. Hence, it is very important that students enter at the commencement of the Term that they may be properly and justly classified.

Course of Study. PRIMARY DEPARTMENT. JUNIOR CLASS.
1st Term—Spelling, Webster's; Reading, Sargent's Series.
2d Term—Spelling and Reading continued; Primary Geography, Cornell's; Mental Arithmetic, Davies; Exercises in Writing.

INTERMEDIATE CLASS.
1st Term—Geography continued; Introductory English Grammar, Bullions; Reading continued; Elements of Written Arithmetic, Davies; Exercises in Writing.
2d Term—Intermediate Geography completed; Analytical English Grammar, Bullions; Elements of Written Arithmetic completed; Primary U. S. History, Quackenbos; Exercises in Writing.

SENIOR CLASS.
1st Term—English Grammar completed; Physical Geography, Warren's; Common School Arithmetic, Davies; Analysis of Words; Towns.
2d Term—Analysis of English Language, Greene's; Arithmetic continued; Smaller Composition, Quackenbos; Higher U. S. History, Stephens.

PREPARATORY DEPARTMENT.
SENIOR CLASS.
1st Term—Latin Grammar Bullions; Latin Reader, Bullions; Elementary Algebra, Davis; History of England, Markham's.
2d Term—Six Books of Caesar, Bullions; Analysis of Latin Sentence, Arnold's second Latin Book; Greek Grammar, Bullions; Greek Reader, Bullions; Elementary Algebra, completed; Natural Philosophy, Quackenbos.

INTERMEDIATE CLASS.
1st Term—Six books of Virgil, Anthon's Greek Reader, completed; Plain Geometry Luemias; Higher Composition and Rhetoric Quackenbos; Kendrick's Greek Ollendorff.

1st Term—Cicero's Select Orations, Anthon's; Xenophon's Memorabilia of Socrates; Anthon's; Trigonometry and Surveying, Loomis; Roman History, Arnold's; Latin Prose Composition, Arnold's.
2d Term—Anthon's; Six books of Homer's Iliad, Anthon's; Greek Prose Composition Arnold's; algebra completed, Astronomy, Brookley's.
The above course will prepare candidates for admission into the Sophomore Class of any of our Southern Colleges. Students, who do not stand a satisfactory examination upon the several studies of each class, will not be allowed the privilege to advance to the next higher, but be retained in such class, till all the studies of it be satisfactorily completed.
