The following is a correct statement of Cotton raised by Stevens & Curton, on 11 acres of subsoil land, which was manured with 100 bags of Carolina Fertilizer. The following is the method of cultivation: It was thoroughly broken up 12 inches deep, and laid in rows 3 feet wide, and the Fertilizer applied in the drill, then bedded on 2 weeks 1st of May, and planted the same day, but owing to the cold and dry weather, it did not come up until about the 1st of June. First working it was run in a row with a half shovels and partially framed out with a hoe. Second working it was run around with a 3 inch grub, 12 inches deep, and 12 inches wide. One furrow to a row and tilled to a stand with a hoe about 12 inches between the stocks, and after wards it was ploughed every 2 to 3 weeks with a sweep 18 inches wide, and hoed each time, and it was worked five times.
