How many fares could a railway conductor collect at the end of his run? Or a gatekeeper after the baseball game is over? Or a life or fire insurance company after the year has ex-pired or the policy has lapsed? We wish to thank our subscribers for the loyal manner in which they have helped us by paying their bills in advance. Ninety per cent have paid us in every town. We had a few at each place to refuse to pay until they un derstood thoroughly the cause of the change. Then these also came manfully to our rescue, for which we are grateful.
