FORD PRODUCING 4,000 CARS A DAY Present Production Greater Than For Same Period Last Year.

Ford is building cars at full speed. And, according to an official statement from the factory at Detroit, the demand for Ford cars and trucks still exceeds the output, despite the fact that a new high level of production has been reached.

By the first of May the figures representing daily production were in the neighborhood of 4,000 a day, so the May schedule was set at 101,125 cars and trucks, not including the output of the Ford Canadian plant or any of the foreign assembling plants.

A comparison of Ford production figures for 1920 and 1921 disclose the fact that for April, 1921, the output was greater by 34,514 than for the corresponding month of a year ago.
