About Cotton Seed and Cot'on Seed Meal.

The thoughtful, progressive farmer may always have an interesting problem to work at, if he so desires. No more interesting one is presented than the proper use of cotton seed.

It is estimated that 100 pounds of good seed will make 35 pounds of meal; or nine bushels will make 100 pounds of meal. It will then require 13 bushels to make 200 pounds of meal, the usual amount to apply to an acre when meal alone is used.

There is a want of information as to the comparative value of seed and meal. A few well directed experiments would throw some light on the subject. Let different farmers try both on corn and cotton with equal applications of seed and meal, or nine bushels of seed to 100 pounds of meal.
