**HOW THE PATASCO WAS SUNK.**  
The Story as Told by Capt. T. A. Huguenin on Eye-Witness.

A reporter for the News and Courier called on Gen. T. A. Huguenin last night and obtained from him an account of the sinking of the United States monitor Patasco during the late war, of which awful tragedy he was an eye-witness. Gen. Huguenin, as will be seen, has a very vivid recollection of the occurrence: "On the evening of the 15th of January, 1865, as usual thearrison of Fort Sumter was placed in its watchful position," said Gen. Huguenin, "the guns and heavy artillery manned, and light batteries run up on the parapet, and the infantry supports placed in position, guards were mounted, and the usual routine observed in every respect. In other words, the fort on this night was put in the same position as was nightly the custom; that is to say, to be on guard for an attack by small boats at any time during the coming night. Thearrison, as we say, was on the quit vive, one-third of whom were on the parapet as sentries, one-third under arms in their quarters, and the other third allowed to sleep with their arms and accoutrements at hand. Under this condition of affairs the report of the approach of a boat, which, upon being hailed and reported, turned out to be a torpedo cut, charged with the duty of laying torpedoes in the channel between Sumter and Moultrie. This special class of torpedo happened to be what was known as the floating torpedo, that is to say, two torpedoes suspended from the end of a line with a whip attached in the middle of the line so that, while floating, as soon as it struck an object the tide would make it close in against the object and by the concussion strike and burst.
