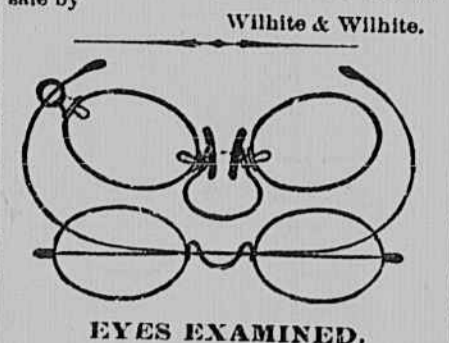
BRUSHY CREEK NEWS. We are having some very fine weather now, and the crops are improving rapidly.
