Our Cable Dispatches. London, February 2.—Rio—Consols for month 90 1/2. Illinois Central 90 1/2. Erie Railway Shares 39. Bonds 78.

February 1.—Finances unchanged since noon. Liverpool, February 1.—P. M.—Cotton closed dull. Sales of 7000 bales. Middling Uplands 14 1/2. Orleans 14 1/2. Breadstuffs dull and easier. Corn has declined to 46 1/2. 6d. per quarter. Beef has advanced a fourth.

February 2.—Evening.—Cotton market closed dull and inactive. Sales of 6000 bales. Prices are firm. Middling Uplands 14 1/2. Breadstuffs quiet. Corn has declined 4/4. for mixed Western. American provisions quiet. Spirits Turpentine 37 1/2. 6d. Manchester, February 1.—Trade is still—prices lower.

London, February 1.—A very destructive earthquake occurred in the West Coast of Africa. The Queen's speech will certainly recommend reform measures.

It is rumored that Mr. Laird himself proposes to pay the Alabama's claims. London, February 2.—Garibaldi has written a letter discouraging the rising at Rome.

Russia protests against the rising of Poles in Galicia. Liverpool, February 1.—The ship Monmouth, from New Orleans for Liverpool, has been abandoned at sea—eight lives were lost.

Paris, February 1.—The Imperial army camps this year at Paris instead of Chalons. Athens, February 1.—It is impossible for the Government to restrain the departure of volunteers for Crete—15,000 have just departed.

Madrid, February 1.—A hundred suspected revolutionists have been arrested. Washington News. Washington, February 3.—Noon.—Intelligence as regards the failure of the tariff in the House is certain.

D. E. Coor, of Alabama; GEORGE R. BOTTRELL, of Memphis; E. F. BROWN, of New Orleans; and GEORGE W. BROWN, of Texas; Hon. THOS. SETTLE, of E. R. Florida; GEORGE W. BROWN, of North Carolina, have arrived here. The Treasury investigations develop no frauds. The impeachment feeling seems to be gaining ground. The Chronicle has a double headed leader urging it.

The Kansas Legislature have passed a concurrent resolution, with only four dissenting votes, urging territorialism. Brown's Corn Patent has been renewed.

February 3.—Col. Coles of the Georgia Railroad, and EDWARD F. BROWN, of the Mississippi Central, are en route for New York. Freight cars from Canton and Grand Junction and Knoxville Railroad in sixty-six hours.

The Reconstruction Committee had a discordant session last night, and meet again on Wednesday. High Democratic authority deprecates the late Convention, on the ground that the extremists will come far to pieces if left alone.

The Kentucky delegation have advised that the gubernatorial contest in their State has been narrowed to Messrs. HARRIS and HAY. Mr. HARRIS has been absent all the session, and will probably not put in an appearance from this time on to the fourth of March, leaving the opposition in command of the field by one majority. Stevens accepts, and is so completely resigned to the situation that he privately avows that he will not make any further effort to secure the nomination.

The Kentucky House caucus in Senate, passed a resolution for an early Congressional election. General Sherman forbids the Indian agents from selling ammunition to the Indians, who he represents as settlers. It is supposed that they meditate a general war in the spring. Both GRANT and SHERMAN regard the trade under the circumstances as infamous.

The Mexican Consul at San Francisco telegraphs that the reported execution of CALIXTA is false. Congressional. Washington, February 2.—SENATE.—The President communicated his message relative to the appointment of persons who were rejected by the Senate, which was ordered to be printed and then laid upon the table.

The Adams Express Company sent in a petition for the re-issue of legal tenders which were burned while in their hands. The letter that leads to the MORTON correspondence has been demanded.

The Bankrupt Bill was resumed. Two thousand homestead exemptions were abundantly discussed and rejected. Pending in the House amendments to the House including Cabinet officers' tenure of office Bill, Mr. Johnson's death was announced, and after the final ceremonies the Senate adjourned.

Homes.—The tenure of office Bill was taken up, and an amendment to include Cabinet officers was adopted by a vote of 82 to 63, and the Bill passed by a vote of 111 to 82. The Bill extending the crew head patents was tabled by a vote of 74 to 62.

The Bill paying the Kentucky militia for being called out to protect Cumberland Gap, was passed. The House then adjourned in respect to PHILIP JOHNSON.

General News. New York, February 2.—Governor HUNT is dead. The steamer R. R. Ogier, seized as a suspected Fenian privateer, had sixty-six Confederates on board. She was heavily armed. The crew was obtained principally from Charleston and Savannah. The master was named E. J. READ.

The Executive Committee of the Southern Relief Commission met this afternoon, and received additional information of the destitution at the South, and took measures to make the working organization Commission complete and effective. The Treasurer, JAMES M. BROWN, reported the receipt of about \$15,000 in the last three days, \$10,000 of which was in the form of subscriptions from A. T. SWANSON and BROWN, BROS. & CO.

Fortress Monroe, February 2.—Noon.—The ice on the Chesapeake is breaking up. St. Louis, February 2.—Noon.—Jefferson city reports represent that the State Militia are robbing the stores. ANAPOLIS, February 2.—Noon.—The Senate has passed a Bill, in which the House will concur, dispensing with Wednesday's Baltimore municipal election.

LAWRENCE, KANSAS, February 3.—Strong salt water has been reached within the city limits, at a depth of 25 feet, and all the ground in the neighborhood has been deluged. A letter from Fort Phil Kearney represents the Indians as very hostile.

FRANKFORT, Ky., February 3.—The House referred to the Committee on Federal Relations the resolutions that the President be requested to issue a general amnesty proclamation. It is that impossible or inexpedient, then the pardon of JOHN C. BRADDOCK is requested.

Marine News. New York, February 2.—The steamer Germania takes out \$375,000, and the City of Boston \$230,000. The steamer Mary, from Mobile, has arrived. The Monaka, from Charleston, has arrived, and the Marion from New Orleans, and the Lord from Memphis.

Bermuda advices state that several vessels had arrived, leaving bad, and having lost their sails, among them the Geo. Glacieir, from Mobile for Providence. The Jacmil Packet, seized at Aspinwall on a charge of battery, has arrived.

The steamer Lancoster, reported lost, was at Barbados, January 1. February 3.—Arrived the steamers General Grant, from New Orleans; General Barnes, from Savannah, and the Albatross, from Norfolk.
