much of the product was carried long distances on the backs of bullocks, and was unloaded every night, often in the mud, and subject to loss and deterioration in various ways. The Bombay Cotton Committee, in 1847, estimated that "the whole charges of conveyance to Bombay from the mart of Kharangoon, only 216 miles distant, being the nearest of all, do not fall short of 60 per cent. on the price of the commodity." We do not find any statement of the current railroad charges; but the cost of transportation has been further reduced by the extension of the use of the cotton press. The conversion of bullock paths into cart roads, in certain cases, has further facilitated the arrival of cotton at market, and it is possible for the government to cheapen its cost yet more at the ports of shipment, by the removal of the tax which it has to pay at the towns to which it is brought.
